Pre-School

Electrical safety is very important regardless of age. Sussex Rural Electric's safety program for Pre -K students centers around our "Hazard Hamlet" Module. "Hazard Hamlet" is a fully integrated display which incorporates sight and sound into training young people to the dangers of electricity in everyday situations. The demonstration is an eye opening experience complete with sparks, sounds, and small power arcs. "Hazard Hamlet" is an educational

device designed to keep the audience focused during the important safety message.

Because of its dynamic and interactive design, the "Hazard Hamlet" module brings the message home in a very dramatic way that keeps the attention of pre-school age children for optimal results in learning and retention. If the schedule permits, a lineman with a bucket-truck may also be available for presentations.
